18-year-old girl from stereotypical family joined Wild as a Trainee two years ago and learned value addition, marketing, community engagement, communication. Recently, she got the chance to participate in the commutiny fellowship as a coanchor of Wild and started the journey as climate change loomed. She got the chance to learn many new things here, especially the program, which helped make her more confident.

The changeloom program started From March, Shivani (founder-wild) and Sangam (beneficiary-wild) had the first residential completed training, where we learn the use of MADE tools to understand the root cause of climate issues and how it's impacting daily life or livelihood of villagers. We got to know the climate actions of our co-participants, who came from different part of India. Coming back from Delhi, we started applying the same tools in our community.



The villagers told us the current problem of thier village, that is drinking water.

Through resource mapping we found nearby water drainage and then we all started worked on it.





Invited DDC to Visit Upaban Farm

Upaban is a farm spread in 16 acres of land in Simultala. 32 years back the land was completely barren, rocky, and belongs to hilly terrain. Initially there were no floura and fauna here, no water used to retains in the land. 32 years back one person started working on it, created lots of water shed structure and planted different types of fruit, food and other trees. Now the land look like a forest patch. We got opportunity to work with him and implements new methodology of farming and mostly natural farming.

The farm is truly a regenerative model of a barren space, especially for hilly region. We invited the DDC of Jamui, to visit and see that how, if one person with his commitment can bring change, why not the government?

And we request them to promote such models in different area of Jamui. He inspired a lot. We are not sure how they will take it in future but we are satisfied enough that at least the project has been seen by government officials and it sets an par/example for them to start a new work in the field of plantation.
